AREMIS Cookie Policy (June 2024 Version)

A cookie is a small text file that can be stored on your computer when you visit websites. Information is recorded in a text file such as your language preference for a website. When you visit the website again later, this cookie is sent back to the website in question. In this way, the website recognizes your browser and can, for example, remember your language preference.

Cookies also generally have an expiration date. Some cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser (so-called session cookies), while others remain on your computer longer, sometimes even until you delete them manually (so-called persistent cookies).

Why do we use cookies?

AREMIS, the manager of this website, uses four types of cookies on its website:

- Essential cookies;
- Functional cookies;
- Analytical cookies;
- Third-party cookies.

To manage the content of its website, AREMIS places essential and functional cookies. These cookies are necessary for the correct functioning of this website. It is not possible to refuse these cookies if you want to visit our website. The lists of these essential and functional cookies are listed below.

AREMIS also uses Google Analytics for analytical purposes. This analysis tool installs cookies that we use to quantify visits (traffic) on the website. This allows us, for example, to know how many times a particular page has been read. We use this information solely to improve the content of our website or as a basis for a new campaign on a certain topic that attracts a lot of interest.

AREMIS also uses several sharing buttons on its site as well as videos hosted on YouTube or content from LinkedIn. These features use third-party cookies directly deposited by these third-party services. The list of these cookies is listed below.

ESSENTIAL COOKIES

These cookies are required for purely technical reasons for a normal visit to the website. Given the technical necessity, only an obligation of information applies, and these cookies are placed as soon as you access the website.

FUNCTIONAL COOKIES

You cannot refuse these cookies if you wish to browse this website, but they are only placed after a choice has been made regarding the placement of cookies.

ANALYTICAL COOKIES

You can refuse the cookies below if you wish to browse our website.

- **Google Analytics:** "Google Analytics" is a service offered by Google Inc. ("Google") that generates detailed statistics about website traffic and traffic sources and measures conversions into sales. Google Analytics uses its own cookies which are stored on your computer to analyze how users navigate the AREMIS website. How to see which cookies are installed on my device and how to delete them?

If you want to know which cookies are installed on your device or if you want to delete them, you can use a setting in your browser. You will find more explanations on how to proceed via the information below.

Here's how to see and delete cookies installed on your device for different browsers:

- **Firefox:**
 - **See cookies:**
 - Click on the menu button (three bars) at the top right and select "Options" or "Preferences".
 - Go to the "Privacy & Security" panel.
 - Under "Cookies and Site Data", click "Manage Data". This will display a list of sites and the number of cookies they have stored.
 - **Delete cookies:**
 - To delete cookies from a specific site, search for the site and click "Remove Selected".
 - To delete all cookies, click "Clear Data", check "Cookies and Site Data", and click "Clear".
- **Chrome:**
 - **See cookies:**
 - Click on the three vertical dots at the top right and go to "Settings".
 - Under "Privacy and Security", click "Cookies and other site data".
 - Click "See all cookies and site data" to see the full list.
 - **Delete cookies:**
 - To delete cookies from a specific site, click the trash can icon next to the site.
 - To delete all cookies, click "Clear browsing data", select "Cookies and other site data", and click "Clear data".
- **Safari:**
 - **See cookies:**
 - Go to "Preferences" via the Safari menu.
 - Under the "Privacy" tab, click "Manage Website Data".
 - **Delete cookies:**
 - To delete cookies from a specific site, select the site and click "Remove".
 - To delete all cookies, click "Remove All".
- **Internet Explorer:**
 - **See cookies:**
 - Click on the gear icon at the top right and select "Internet Options".
 - Under the "General" tab, click "Settings" in the "Browsing history" section.
 - Click "View files" to see the cookies.
 - **Delete cookies:**
 - In "Internet Options" under the "General" tab, click "Delete" in the "Browsing history" section.
 - Check "Cookies and website data" and click "Delete".
- **Mobile Browsers (Firefox, Chrome, Safari, Microsoft Edge):**
 - **Firefox Mobile:**
 - Open the menu, go to "Settings" then "Privacy & Security". Under "Data Management", you can see and delete cookies.

- **Chrome Mobile:**
 - Open the menu, go to "Settings" then "Privacy and Security". Click "Clear browsing data" and select "Cookies and site data".
- **Safari Mobile:**
 - Go to "Settings", select "Safari" then "Advanced" and "Website Data". You can see and delete cookies here.
- **Microsoft Edge:**
 - Open the menu, go to "Settings" then "Privacy and Security". Under "Clear browsing data", you can manage and delete cookies.
